On page 219 of John Culme's definitive book *The Directory of Gold and Silversmiths*, it describes Harvey & Co's offerings at the Great Exhibition of 1851 and alluringly described are "a pair of chased candlesticks, Boys and Dolphins". Silver Hallmarked by Robert John Harvey is rare and the exceptional quality of this pair makes it likely they were made for a special purpose, such as the London Great Exhibition of the Works of Industry of All Nations 1851.
